Description

Magic Sonic are noise reduction earbuds that come as a pair. They have a simple yet effective design of 3 resonators that selectively reduce high pitched noises in the 6000Hz range. They dampen the shrill noises commonly found in dental settings that lead to hearing damage. Speech and other environmental sounds remain unchanged, giving the wearer the ability to hear and carry on conversations.

Indication

· Used to reduce noise from dental equipment

Unique Attributes

- · Easy to clean design and can be sterilized in an autoclave
- · Does not create a full or stuffy sensation in the ear
- Allows lower frequency sounds, such as speech, to still be heard

Clinical Tips

- Take a look for the side markings, so you put the correct piece in the corresponding ear
- Gently place in ear, do not press hard
- A good option to provide to patients who find the noises of dental proceedures uncomfortable
